



Support for Knowledge Exchange visits

This program aims to enable researchers at any stage of career development to familiarize themselves with everyday health and social issues experienced by individuals with Down syndrome. Investigators whose work is in fundamental, translational, or clinical research in Down syndrome are eligible to apply. Clinical researchers can make use of this program to enhance recruiting and testing procedures and to harmonize practices across clinical research groups. Only T21RS members can apply. A budget to cover the cost of travel and lodging, up to a maximum of 5,000 EUR, will be allowed. Applications will be received on a continuing basis. Funding decisions are made by a committee that reports to the T21RS Executive Committee. We anticipate funding up to three such applications per year. A full report of progress is required at the time of project completion. The template for the final report will be provided to awardees at the time of funding.
